- ◆ Students should contact their Community College advisor to ensure that all degree and graduation requirements for the Community College are met.

### Ashford University Guidelines:

- ◆ Students transferring with an Associate's degree with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA and recognized as meeting the General Education requirement at their state universities will have fulfilled all lower division General Education requirements at Ashford University. The Introductory and General Education Capstone courses must still be completed at Ashford University.
- Completion of a minimum of 30 credits of upper division coursework, including 18 credits of upper-division coursework in the major, is required for a Bachelor's Degree.
- Course requirement waived with conferred Associate's degree.
   However total credit requirement remains and transfers over to the elective pool.
- † Ashford major requirement met in transfer from Community College of Baltimore County.
